The event is based at Priddy Village Hall, Priddy, Wells, BA5 3BE.

The first car will start at 10:30am with 47 mile section before lunch then a 47 mile section in the afternoon before returning to Priddy Village Hall for a hot meal around 15:15pm (for the first car).

Regulations

1. Organisation.

Tavern Motor Club will organise and promote the Summers End Tour.

A Touring Assembly for classic cars held on Saturday 26th September 2026.

The event is held under a certificate of exemption issued by Motorsport UK, these Regulations and any written instructions that the organisers may issue for the event.

The event has no competitive element. The Motorsport UK Event Permit number is: **TBC**

2. Eligibility.

The event is open to four-wheeled road cars first registered before 1st January 2000

Interesting later cars may be accepted at the organisers discretion.

Cars must not carry any advertising/sign writing unless by previous arrangement with the organisers. The display of any competition number/s is not allowed. A driver and navigator name on the front wing is permitted.

Any vehicle, which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start.

3. Entries.

Entries open on publication of these Regulations, and close on 19th September 2026. Please return your entry form via email or post accompanied by the entry fee of £110.00 for two people travelling in the car. Please add **£30** for each additional person. The entry fee includes a £5.00 carbon offset fee. Each entry will be acknowledged by e-mail. The entry fee includes one Tulip Road book, one rigid tour plate, **Breakfast roll with tea/coffee, lunchtime cake with tea/coffee and a hot meal at the end of the event.** There will be a bar at the Village Hall at the finish.

The maximum number of cars on the event is 40. The minimum is 25. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full.

4. Route.

The event will start and finish at:

Priddy Village Hall, Priddy, Wells, BA5 3BE.

The first car will leave at 10.30am. The route will cover approximately 94 miles on the Mendip Hills and Somerset Levels.

The route will be given in an easy-to-follow Tulip Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at Signing-on. Although not required to complete the route, entrants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' maps 182 and 183.

Along the route, there will be Check Points to observe the entrants adherence to the defined route. At each point the entrants Route Check Card will be signed. These Check Points will be open for specified periods, giving adequate time to visit them while they are open.

5. Timetable.

The timetable for the event will be as follows:

Tuesday 22nd September - Final Instructions sent via e mail.

Saturday 26th September.

9.00am Signing on.

10.00am Drivers Briefing

10.30am First car starts

12.10pm First car arrives at the Coffee Halt.

15.00pm First car arrives at Priddy Village Hall.

15:15pm End of event meal served.

6. Documentation.

Cars/Entrants must arrive at the start not later than 09.45am.

The following, documents must be available for inspection if requested:

- Driving License for the driver.
- V5C Registration Document.
- MOT Certificate if applicable

All entrants must ensure that the vehicle has a road fund licence (if applicable) and adequate insurance to enter the event. The driver will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation.

After documentation, entrants will be given their Tour Plate to be fixed to the front of the vehicle, Tulip Road Book, and Route Check Card. They will also receive their Morning, Lunch and Meal Vouchers.
